



**NCR SCCA – CAPE FEAR CHAPTER
SOLO CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES
SUPPLEMENTARY RULES & REGULATIONS**

ELIGIBILITY: The series is open to all North Carolina Region SCCA member drivers eligible under section 4 of the most current SCCA SOLO RULES.

Eligible cars include those that meet the requirements under section 12 of the most current SCCA SOLO RULES.

Car classifications and levels of car preparation are to be determined by use of the most current SCCA SOLO RULES.

EVENTS: The series will consist of a number of events to be held throughout the year put on by the North Carolina Region, SCCA. Drivers must complete a minimum number of events to qualify for championship points. If a driver joins NCR SCCA by the third event, any points earned during the first two events will be included in the championship points. If a driver joins NCR SCCA after the third event, only points from the forth onward will be included.

Scoring is to be based on a driver's total accumulation of points earned in a single class (transfers are not permitted) in the number of events that are counted. Scoring will be based on counting a driver's best finishes according to the following schedule:

AWARDS: Year-end championship awards will be given to the driver that has accumulated the highest point total in each of the classes designated by the most current SCCA SOLO RULES and to the driver in Ladies Class that has accumulated the highest points total based on their computed times. In the event that no eligible drivers exist in a given class, no award will be given for that class.

SCORING: Points are to be assigned within a class as follows: 9 for 1st place, 6 for 2nd place, 4 for 3rd place, 3 for 4th place, 2 for 5th place, 1 for 6th place.

A Ladies Class will be available for all ladies who wish to enter into this class rather than running in Open Class. Scoring for the Ladies Class will be based upon times as computed using the most current PAX Index multipliers.
